

RailWorks 3 – Train Simulator 2012

Class 483 Headlight Modification

Hello. Thank you for downloading my first Headlight modification for RailWorks 3: Train Simulator 2012.

What does this modification do?

RailWorks 3 was upgraded with brand new headlights that actually illuminate track and objects ahead of the train, when you switch on the headlights as you would normally. This was only fitted to default (core) RW stock (such as the Class 47, HST etc). This is a **temporary** modification until RailSimulator.Com releases an update to fix the IOW stock.

How do I install it?

Providing you have extracted the .zip file to somewhere handy (desktop is ideal), just follow the instructions below.

First off, go to this folder:

**C:\Program Files
(x86)\Steam\steamapps\common\railworks\Assets\Kuju\RailSimulator\RailVehicles\Diesel\Class47\Default**

And now copy the entire folder called “Lights”.

Now, go to this folder:

**C:\Program Files
(x86)\Steam\steamapps\common\railworks\Assets\RSDL\IslandLine\RailVehicles\Electric\Class483**

And paste the folder into here.

Next, copy the “Default” and “NSE” folders from the extracted folder into the folder you are in (the Class 483 one).

When asked to overwrite, say yes.

Finally, launch RailWorks 3 and on the splash/start-up screen, select the “Tools & Docs” tab. Click on the button that says “Clear cache” and launch RailWorks 3 on your favourite route.
